Stay up-to-date with the current HMT trail maps!

It is very important that you have an accurate trail map. Please note that tablets and other apps purchased from third party companies are typically not regularly updated and may contain inaccurate information.

Due to trail maintenance, mining activity, resource extraction or other reasons, sections of our trails can be temporarily closed for a certain period of time. It is important that everyone has the most current version of the trail maps and observes all signage out on the trails.

Report a Problem feature!

Each trail map contains a QR code that allows you to report issues along the trail such as trees down, rock slides and other issues. This feature pings the location and allows for a photo of the issue to be uploaded. We encourage guests to utilize this communication platform so that issues can be resolved quickly and effectively.

HMT Info App!

Each trail map contains a QR code that pinpoints the locations for the Hatfield-McCoy Administrative Office, Hatfield-McCoy Welcome Center, Country Roads Byway Visitor Center, all HMT trailheads/parking areas and community connectors.
