



The Bearwallow Trail System is located near the ATV-friendly City of Logan, WV. Bearwallow also has access to the ATV-friendly communities of Chapmanville, West Logan and Fountain Place Mall. It is one of the original three trail systems of the Hatfield-McCoy Trails. Its mix of easy-riding scenic vistas and difficult ORV trails make it one of the more popular systems for the Hatfield-McCoy Trails. This trail system has direct access to gas, food and lodging. Bearwallow is open to ORVs as well as ATVs, UTVs and off-road motorcycles.

The Bearwallow Trailhead, located at 247 Bearwallow Drive, Ethel, WV 25076, offers a 2+ acre parking lot, staffed trailhead and on-site restrooms. This facility offers: Trail Permits, Complete Line of Hatfield McCoy Trails Merchandise, Maps, Brochures and Area Information. The Bearwallow Trailhead is staffed seven days a week (except major holidays) from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Be sure to stop by and visit the Country Roads Byway Visitors Center! This facility is located at 40 Welcome Center Drive, Logan, WV 25601. Only a few miles from the City of Logan, on Route 73. This facility offers: Trail Permits, Complete Line of Hatfield McCoy Trails Merchandise, Maps, Brochures, History and Cultural Information. The Country Roads Byway Visitors Center is staffed seven days a week (except major holidays) from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
