



Cabwaylingo State Forest sits on nearly 8,300 acres of land in southern West Virginia. Its colorful name was chosen as a combination of the four closest West Virginia counties surrounding the forest – Cabell, Wayne, Lincoln, and Mingo. ATV, UTV, ORV (Jeeps) and dirt bike riders will find nearly 100 miles of new trails to explore, plenty of parking for trucks and trailers and a trailhead facility with trail permits and Hatfield-McCoy Trails merchandise for sale.

The Cabwaylingo Trailhead, located at 39 Tick Ridge Rd. Wilsondale, WV 25699, offers a 2+ acre parking lot, staffed trailhead and on-site restrooms. This facility offers: Trail Permits, Complete Line of Hatfield McCoy Trails Merchandise, Maps, Brochures and Area Information. The Cabwaylingo Trailhead is staffed seven days a week (open 365 days a year) from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
